‘Ding’ film winds up season anti-plastic

The documentary film “Bag It: Is Your Life Too Plastic?” completes the fourth annual “Ding” Darling Wednesday Film Series on April 13, 2016, at 2:30 p.m. in the “Ding” Darling Visitor & Education Center auditorium.

“Bag It,” begins its mission with the ill effects of plastic bags, then evolves into a wholesale investigation into plastic and its effect on waterways, oceans, wildlife, and our own bodies. It connects the dots between plastic and around 100,000 marine animal deaths each year, plus human disease from male infertility to diabetes.

The multi-award-winning, 65-minute documentary reveals just how plastic crazy we really are and how we can change the pattern.

“Ding” Darling Wildlife Society-Friends of the Refuge hosts the free eight-film, biweekly series with sponsorship from Sanibel-Captiva Beach Resorts. Seating is free, but limited and on a first-come basis.
